

International Virtual Learning Academy (IVLA) is a fully accredited, NCAA approved private school for students in kindergarten through grade twelve that has served students for nearly twenty years. IVLA is accredited by Cognia in the United States of America and is available to students in the U.S. and internationally who are seeking a flexible U.S. education and diploma. Our students meet their educational goals and grow academically with the support of fully certified and caring online teachers.

Since our establishment in 2007, IVLA has been the school of choice for the college prep student or any student looking for a self-paced, flexible, and asynchronous option. Our student body is represented by nearly 50 countries. We understand that students have different needs, academic goals, and abilities. As such, at IVLA we strive to meet the needs of every student exactly where they are. One way we achieve this is offering many different curriculum options that families can choose from to best meet their learners' needs.

International Virtual Learning Academy's online high school offers more than 2,000 challenging and diverse courses. Each semester-long course earns 0.5 credits, and students have 5 months to complete the course. Each year-long course earns 1.0 credit, and students have 10 months to complete the course. Full-time students spend anywhere between 3-5 hours a day working both on and offline.

With rolling enrollment, IVLA provides students the opportunity to enroll or re-enroll at any time. Students are provided with the flexibility they need to thrive. Over 200 IVLA courses meet the University of California (UC) A-G requirements, and over 75 of IVLA courses are approved by the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA). Students are also about to join IVLA's online National Honor Society Chapter (NHS). Students in grades 9 through 12 also have the opportunity to take online dual credit college courses while enrolled with us. Along with dual enrollment, students have the option of several AP courses offered.
